

Greenwood Township February 3, 2026 Regular Meeting

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. By Shelly Bigelow.
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

Board members present: Shelly Bigelow, Terry Vandercook, Nancy Mohler, Harold Swinehart Absent: Melody Baker

Public comment: Discussion about the 2 day power outage that effected part of Greenwood Township.

The minutes for January 6, 2026 regular meeting were presented. Motion made by T Vandercook supported by H Swinehart to accept the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

The bills were presented for January and February. Motion made by N Mohler supported by H Swinehart to accept the February bills as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

N Mohler was contacted by the Vice President of the Teamsters Union out of Detroit. They were interested in using the Greenwood Township Hall to hold a meeting. Greenwood Township made a motion at a past meeting that only Greenwood Township residents may rent the township hall. Since his organization is outside of our township this meeting would not be allowed.

S Bigelow confirmed that Larry Laxton will make out a W-4 to be paid for his time on the Board of Review.

Dave Gladysz put in his resignation tonight to not be an active member of the fire board. Motion made by S Bigelow supported by T Vandercook to accept Daves resignation and appoint Larry Laxton to replace as the new fire board member. Motion passed unanimously.

N Mohler received notices from Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) stating they will be putting temporary bridges over the Soper and Apple Creeks in Greenwood Township to access state forest land for timber harvesting. These temporary bridges will be in place for approximately 12 months or until the harvest is complete.

S Bigelow told the board Par Plan Grants are now open to apply for. You have to be with Par Plan 6 months to be able to apply so this year Greenwood does not qualify.

N Mohler asked about the free "water bugs" that were offered from Par Plan. S Bigelow said she received them and will bring them to the Township Hall.

N Mohler told the board that Jonathon Hallett had contacted her and said his 1099 was incorrect. N Mohler contacted UHY and informed them of this error.

Motion made by H Swinehart supported by T Vandercook to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
