Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by S Bigelow.
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

The minutes for the February 3, 2026 regular meeting were presented. Motion made by T Vandercook supported by H Swinehart to accept the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

The bills were presented for March. Motion made by M Baker supported by H Swinehart to accept the March bills as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Old business:

Still need to get a spare Filter for the generator.

New business:

S Bigelow told the board that the township must comply with technical requirements for local governments to make sure that all website and any mobile apps are accessible to people with disabilities. The dead line for this is April 26, 2027.

S Bigelow will reach out to Allpro Technologies to get our analytics to see how many people use the website and see what it will cost to do this update.

N Mohler told the board that the version of Quickbooks online that was installed did not have a budget included. Motion made by N Mohler supported by M Baker to upgrade Quickbooks online to include a budget function. Motion passed unanimously.

After a discussion, a motion was made by M Baker supported by T Vandercook to hold the Township Budget Planning Meeting on March 17, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. and the Budget Hearing Meeting at 8:00 p.m. Motion passed unanimously. N Mohler will submit the information to the Cadillac News so it can be published at least 6 days before the meeting.

Nancy will look into getting Veteran Flag holders and Flags that are made in American for memorial day.

N Mohler will call Adam Gandolfi about the liability of hall rentals or if the township hall was used for power outage situations.

March is Board of Review. Dave Gladysz, Hannah Elliot, Larry Laxton, Al Mohler will be the members that make up the board with S Bigelow being the secretary.

Fire Department:

The fire department has been working on 1.00 mill for the last 48 years. The Fire Board would like to propose a .50 mill increase to the fire department mileage. They would like to try and have this proposal on the August ballot. Both township boards must pass this proposal before this goes on the ballot.

T Vandercook presented the treasurers report. Motion made by N Mohler supported by H Swinehart to accept the report as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

T Vandercook was going to check Certificates of Deposit interest rates. Motion made by N Mohler supported by M Baker to allow T Vandercook to move the current CD's if the interest was higher. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment:

Al Mohler suggested different options should be considered for future dump days. One suggestion would be to give residents a pass to the landfill. No decision was made.

Motion made by T Vandercook supported by H Swinehart to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
