

## Greenwood Township April 7, 2026 Regular Meeting

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. by S Bigelow.  
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

**Minutes:** Minutes were presented for the March 3, 2026 regular meeting. Motion made by T Vandercook supported by H Swinehart to accept the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Minutes for the the March 17, 2026 special Budget Planning meeting were presented. Motion made by M Baker supported by H Swinehart to accept the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

Minutes for the the March 17, 2026 special Budget Hearing meeting were presented. Motion made by T Vandercook supported by M Baker to accept the minutes as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

**Bills:** The bills for the April meeting were presented. Motion made by M Baker supported by H Swinehart to accept the bills as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

**Old Business:** Keeping the Website compliant. The township has until April 26, 2027 to become compliant. The fine could be \$7500.00 per each infraction. The township needs to know what it will take to get the website up-to date and the cost of the update. S Bigelow had the analytics for the website to see how much the website is actually used. Motion made by T Vandercook supported by N Mohler to have Rob from AllPro Technologies attend the next meeting to go over costs and time to make the township compliant. Motion passed unanimously.

N Mohler received 2 quotes to fix the townships Quickbooks on Line. Balanced by Lori out of Traverse City wants \$4800.00 to take care of the errors. Her estimate said this could take 2 to 4 weeks.

UHY would charge \$100.00 for part 1 of the repair with an estimated time of 5 hours and part 2 of the repair would cost \$200.00 per hour with an estimated time of 5 hours. Motion made by T Vandercook supported by H Swinehart to have UHY do the repairs. Motion passed unanimously.

Fire extinguishers were inspected and are approved for a year.

**Supervisor:** Greenwood Township should qualify for the fall Par Plan Grant Program of \$5000.00. Things suggested for this grant but not limited to:

- Cement for the end of the handicap ramp
- More work on the generator cover
- Extra cameras at the township hall and cemetery

**Fire Department:** The fire department was very busy with the ice storms.

The fire department is up for renewal on the millage of 1 Mil that has been in place for as long as the fire department has had the millage. They would also like to add an additional .50 mil on the ballot for the August election.

It was not stated on the ballot proposal what the .50 mill would be used for.

After a lengthy discussion, motion made by T Vandercook supported by M Baker to accepted the renewal millage for the August ballot. Roll call vote was called:
